Spiritual: through attending 2 chapel sessions each day plus group Bible study with their cabin group.

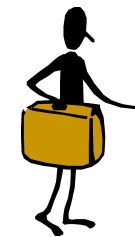
Physical: through a wide variety of activities such as group games, canoeing, hiking, fishing, archery and crafts.

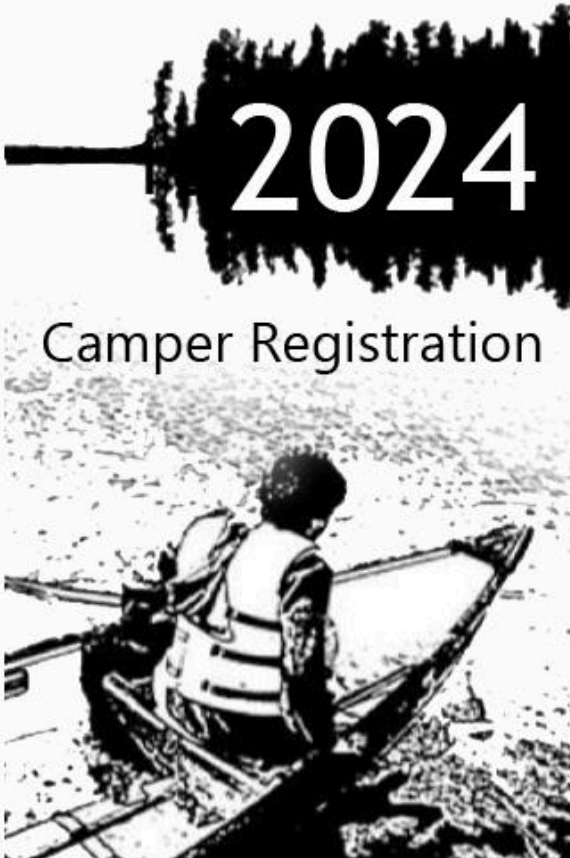
Packing List:
